Dr Diana Mansour is a Consultant in Community Gynaecology and Reproductive Health Care and Head of Clinical Services for sexual health in Newcastle upon Tyne. She has been an Associate Clinical Lecturer at Newcastle University since 1997. In addition Dr Mansour is the Honorary



Treasurer and an Officer for the Faculty of Sexual and Reproductive Healthcare. She is the Lead Officer for the Clinical Effectiveness Committee and FSRH Journal.

Dr Mansour was the first accredited subspecialty trainee in Community Gynaecology and Reproductive Health Care of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists.
