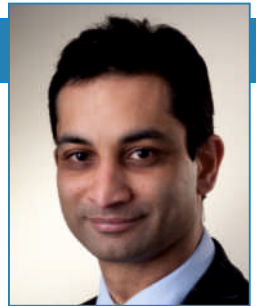


He is the lead electrophysiologist for the rapid access palpitation clinic and open access Atrial Fibrillation clinic.

He performs over 250 catheter ablations annually for the treatment of heart rhythm disorders, with a particular focus on curative AF ablation.

Dr Washik Parkar graduated in 1992 from Liverpool Medical School. He has spent a number of years in hospitals, undertaking various medical posts, before becoming a General Practitioner and a North West Deanery GP trainer.



After completing additional training in cardiology, he became a clinical lead for the Manchester Primary Care Cardiology service. He has advised CCG's on cardiovascular strategies. He has written Cardiac network guidance and has been consulted by NICE regarding medtech innovation ECG monitoring. He is still working as a GP in Trafford and a clinical assistant in cardiology at St Helens and Knowsley Trust.
