## Meet the Speakers ...

### Dr Handrean Soran

Dr Handrean Soran is a consultant physician and endocrinologist with a specialist interest in lipidology, calcium and bone metabolism.

He received his MRCP diploma from Royal College of Physicians Edinburgh in 1998, MSc in diabetes and endocrinology from Liverpool University in 2006 and MD in medicine from Manchester University in 2010.

He was elected as Fellow of Royal College of Physicians Edinburgh in 2009.

He provides a tertiary centre lipoprotein disorder and calcium and metabolic bone disease service.

He is the lead of Cardiovascular Clinical Trials Unit at Central Manchester University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. His research work is mainly based on cardiovascular risk, lipoprotein metabolism, LDL quality, HDL functionality and Obesity.

He has successfully supervised MD and PhD students. Dr Handrean Soran is the endocrinology and diabetes associate training programme director and education lead North West Deanery.



### Professor Alistair S Hall

Alistair Hall is a Professor of Clinical Cardiology at the University of Leeds and a Consultant Cardiologist at Leeds General Infirmary. His research team forms part of the overarching Multidisciplinary Cardiovascular Research Centre (MCRC) at Leeds.

Professor Hall is involved, among other things, in the Wellcome Trust Case Control Consortium (WTCCC), British Heart Foundation Projects Grants Committee, the European Cardiovascular Research Forum, is a Nucleus Working Group Member of the European Society of Cardiology, and is Lead for the West Yorkshire Comprehensive Cardiovascular Specialty Group.

Professor Hall has been recognised for his contributions to cardiovascular research through various awards.

His previous awards include the Scientific American Research Leader of the Year for Wellcome Trust Case Control Consortium and American Heart Association first and second position in the "Top 10 Papers of the Year" for 2007.

Professor Hall has authored 169 scientific publications to date.
