Dr Javaid qualified from Cambridge University and completed his GP VTS training in Northampton. He has an interest in cardiology and echocardiography and was a clinical lead in the Northamptonshire Community Cardiology service, which had a focus on patients with heart failure and valve disease.

More recently he has become involved in a number of cardiology up-skilling projects within primary care in the East Midlands with the aim to improve the optimisation of patients with heart failure, atrial fibrillation and stable coronary disease. He is passionate about ensuring that the best and current evidence is translated into frontline general practice and his work has been acknowledged recently by being named “GP of the Year” for reducing stroke emergency admissions in the East Midlands. He is also a council member of the British Heart Valve Society and on the editorial board for the British Journal of Cardiology.

Dr Ravi Assomull qualified from Cambridge University and undertook his training in Cardiology in North West London where he has continued to work as a Consultant Cardiologist in Coronary Intervention. He was recently appointed as the clinical lead for community cardiology within Ealing CCG (a service delivered by Imperial College NHS Trust).

As part of his strategy for a truly integrated community service, he has developed and delivered an RCGP accredited ECG course to GPs within Ealing CCG and has been tasked with delivering a formal upskilling program with his friend and colleague Dr Yassir Javaid. These two initiatives will serve to further break down any perceived barriers between primary and specialist care and will facilitate improvements in delivery of an already highly regarded service.
