## Meet the Speaker ...

### Diana Mansour

MBBCH, FRCOG, FFSRH, DIPM

Dr Diana Mansour is a Consultant in Community Gynaecology and Reproductive Health Care and Head of Clinical Services for sexual health in Newcastle upon Tyne. She has been an Associate Clinical Lecturer at Newcastle University since 1997. In addition Dr Mansour is Vice President, Clinical Quality and an Officer for the Faculty of Sexual and Reproductive Healthcare. She chairs the FSRH Clinical Effectiveness Committee that develops and updates all FSRH clinical guidelines. Diana is the Lead Officer for FSRH Clinical Standards Committee, the FSRH Priority Setting Partnership and FSRH Journal.

Dr Mansour was the first accredited subspecialty trainee in Community Gynaecology and Reproductive Health Care of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. Dr Mansour is first author to over 80 peer-reviewed publications and has most recently published in Contraception and the Journal of Family Planning and Reproductive Health Care. In September 2015 she co-wrote with Laura Percy a textbook for primary care 'Contraception Made Easy'.

Dr Mansour's areas of expertise include acceptability of contraceptive methods, non-contraceptive benefits of contraception, development of long-term methods of contraception, changes in health service provision, medical management of heavy menstrual bleeding, menopause and hormone replacement therapy.
