Meet the Speakers ...

Professor Chris Probert

Professor Probert graduated from University of Birmingham in 1985 and undertook clinical training in the East Midlands, then the South West. He obtained his MD in 1993 for the study of the epidemiology of inflammatory bowel disease in South Asian migrants and later undertook a BDF (now CORE) funded research fellowship at Harvard for 2 years, with Prof Rick Blumberg, studying the mucosal immunology of inflammatory bowel disease. He was appointed to the post of Senior Lecturer, Reader, then Professor at University of Bristol and

was clinical lead for inflammatory bowel diseases at University Hospital Bristol NHS Foundation Trust.

He has a major research interest in the study of volatile organic compounds for disease diagnosis and leads laboratory research in mucosal immunology and fibrosis in inflammatory bowel disease. He is National Secretary for CCUK (NACC), National Medical Advisor to IA (UK) and sits on several BSG committees. He was appointed to Professor of Gastroenterology at University of Liverpool, in 2011.



Dr Neeraj Prasad is the endoscopy lead and endoscopy training lead for the Gastroenterology department at Royal Albert Hospital, Wigan. Dr Prasad has developed sub speciality interests in therapeutic endoscopy, capsule endoscopy, inflammatory bowel disease, celiac disease and the management of Clostridium Difficile infection.
