## Meet the Speakers ...

### Ben Grey

Ben Grey is a Consultant Urological Surgeon at Central Manchester University Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (CMFT), working at Manchester Royal Infirmary and Trafford General Hospitals. He is also Honorary Professor at the University of Salford and Honorary Senior Lecturer at the University of Manchester. Ben is proud to have been awarded the prestigious British Association of Urological Surgeons (BAUS) John Anderson Award in 2015 which recognises an individual who has contributed to urology in an outstanding or inspirational way.

Ben practices all components of general urology but he has subspecialty interests in urinary tract (kidney, ureter, bladder) stone management. An active researcher, with over 30 publications and book chapters to date, he received his research doctorate (MD) from the University of Manchester after an intensive study of prostate stem cell biology at the Christie Hospital.

### Satish Maddineni

Mr Satish Maddineni graduated from the University Of Edinburgh Medical School in 1996. His basic surgical training was at the University Hospital of Wales in Cardiff. After a 2 year period of research in Bladder and Prostate cancer with Cancer Research UK, based at the Christie Hospital in Manchester, Mr Maddineni gained the higher degree of MD in targeted therapies in the treatment of muscle invasive bladder cancer affiliated to the University of Manchester.

His higher specialist Urology training has been undertaken in the North West Deanery with specialist urological oncology surgical training throughout at tertiary cancer centres. Mr Maddineni has also undertaken further training in laparoscopic radical bilateral nerve sparing prostatectomy at the Erasmus University in Brussels, Belgium under the mentorship of one of Europe's leading minimally invasive laparoscopic prostate cancer surgeons.

Mr Maddineni is now the lead in minimally invasive urological surgery at Salford Royal NHS Foundation Trust, one of the North West's premier urological units and NHS Trusts. Here he mentors surgical trainees and fellow Consultants in minimally invasive surgical techniques. He has also recently been appointed as the Cancer Lead for Urological Surgery at the Trust.

### Professor Noel Clarke

Noel Clarke has been a consultant urologist at Salford Royal Hospital and The Christie, Manchester, since 1993 and was made honorary professor of urological oncology by Manchester University in 1997. His specialist expertise is in prostate, bladder, renal and testis cancer and complex pelvic and retroperitoneal malignancy. Professor Clarke is a former director of urology at both Salford and The Christie, chair of the Manchester and Cheshire clinical study group (CSG) and National Cancer Research Institute prostate CSG. He is currently director of Manchester University's Genitourinary Cancer Research Group, a member of the Department of Health and National Cancer Research Network prostate cancer advisory boards, chair of the European Organisation for Research and Treatment of Cancer prostate disease group and author of over 150 publications, including eight book chapters on urological cancer. Professor Clarke has planned and managed multiple trials in the UK and Europe and given various national and international guest lectures on urological cancer

### Veronica Hall

Veronica Hall MSc, BSc (hons) is a Nurse Consultant in Gastroenterology and is lead clinician for IBD services at Royal Bolton NHS Foundation Trust. She is the joint author of IBD degree module at Salford University and is currently developed a post graduate certificate in gastrointestinal disorders She has several publications in in peer reviewed journals and is joint author/editor of national RCN resource on the management of diarrhoea project

### Dr Neeraj Prasad

Dr Neeraj Prasad is the endoscopy lead and endoscopy training lead for the Gastroenterology department at Royal Albert Hospital, Wigan. Dr Prasad has developed sub speciality interests in therapeutic endoscopy, capsule endoscopy, inflammatory bowel disease, celiac disease and the management of Clostridium Difficile infection.
