Recently, working towards retirement, he has moved to take up a post as Clinical Fellow in the Sexual Health Services with University Hospitals Bristol NHS FT. Stephen considers these to be the best jobs in the NHS, probably in the world, thanks to the Teams.

Sally Hope has been a GP Principal, 1986-2012 at the Woodstock Surgery, Oxfordshire. She founded the Primary Care Group in Gynaecology in 1990.
