Dr Luvai trained in medical biochemistry and metabolic medicine in the Yorkshire Deanery and was subsequently appointed as a consultant in Carlisle in 2014. He runs lipids and cardiovascular risk prevention clinics at Cumberland Infirmary and West Cumberland Hospital. He leads the Familial Hypercholesterolaemia service which includes a genetic testing programme for the North, East and West Cumbria. He is a member of the Lipid Specialists Advisory Group within the Northern England Strategic Clinical Networks. The group aims to promote evidence based practice in the management of lipid disorders, including FH, raise the profile of Lipid Specialist Services, inform commissioners and influence investment decisions.

He also provides a clinical and diagnostic service addressing the metabolic aspects of nutrition support, renal stone disease and bone disease. His laboratory interests are; derivation, transference and verification of reference intervals, performance of clinical decision limits and the impact of biological variation on disease monitoring.
