Dr Cindy Farmer MFSRH, Dip GUM

Dr Cindy Farmer, MFSRH, Dip GUM works for Unity Sexual Health which is part of University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust and covers Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire. She is the Education and Training Lead for the service and runs a complex implant removal service for deep and impalpable implants.

Cindy is the Chair of the General Training Committee of the Faculty of Sexual and Reproductive Healthcare (FSRH) and is on the guideline development group for a new guidance being produced on Contraception and Obesity.

She has worked with the Centre for Pharmacy Postgraduate Education (CPPE) to update their modules on Emergency Contraception and Chlamydia. She also worked with her local pharmaceutical committee and commissioners to agree local training arrangements for supply of oral emergency contraception (levonorgestrel and ulipristal acetate) by PGD.

Mr James Roach

James is an experienced NHS Director having worked in Director roles in hospitals, clinical commissioning groups and in joint roles with social care.

Amongst his previous roles he has run a cancer hospital, been a Chief Executive of a CCG and a system wide Director of Transformation and integration. Currently he is the Director of the West Essex Integrated Care Partnership.

James has passion for clinical innovation , service redesign and developing more services in a community setting. James led the National Innovation Programme on behalf of the National Pharmacy Association with the aim of developing a new profile and platform for community pharmacy locally and nationally in a range of different clinical areas.

James has recently co-authored a national report on how Community Pharmacy could provide 18 million consultations in Primary Care.
