I qualified from QUB in 1999. I completed my GP training in 2004, before taking up GP Partnership in Crossgar. A sabbatical to Brisbane in 2012/13 saw my interest in skin lesion recognition grow. I undertook several courses in dermoscopy and skin cancer management.

I am currently a Clinical Teaching Fellow in the Centre for Medical Education at OUB; GPwSI Dermatology, Southern Trust; Sessional GP Rathfriland and Clinical Lead for Practice Based learning at the Federation Support unit.

I was clinical lead for Dermatology Elective Care Reform in South Eastern Trust and have recent taken up post as GPER (enhanced role) in dermatology in the GP Federations.

I established GP Dermoscopy NI in 2014 and still run educational events on dermoscopy and lesion recognition. I was awarded best Poster Prize at World Congress of Dermoscopy in Thessaloniki, Greece in June, 2018 for my work in education of GPs in lesion recognition.
