Dr Deepa Narayanan

I am a consultant in Chemical pathology and metabolic medicine at Hull and East Yorkshire Hospitals NHS Trust since 2016.

After graduation in 2002, I received the Membership of the Royal College of Physicians diploma in 2006 and elected as the Fellow of the Royal College of Pathologists in 2014.

I provide tertiary lipid and cardiovascular risk reduction service and metabolic bone disease service covering an extended population of 1.2 million.

I am the regional clinical Lead for the dedicated Yorkshire and Humber Familial Hypercholesterolaemia (FH) service.

I am the principal investigator for multicentre trials in cardiovascular medicine.



Professor Alistair S Hall

Alistair Hall is a Professor of Clinical Cardiology at the University of Leeds and a Consultant Cardiologist at Leeds General Infirmary. His research team forms part of the overarching Multidisciplinary Cardiovascular Research Centre (MCRC) at Leeds.

Professor Hall is involved, among other things, in the Wellcome Trust Case Control Consortium (WTCCC), British Heart Foundation Projects Grants Committee, the

European Cardiovascular Research Forum, is a Nucleus Working Group Member of the European Society of Cardiology, and is Lead for the West Yorkshire Comprehensive Cardiovascular Specialty Group.

Professor Hall has been recognised for his contributions to cardiovascular research through various awards.

His previous awards include the Scientific American Research Leader of the Year for Wellcome Trust Case Control Consortium and American Heart Association first and second position in the "Top 10 Papers of the Year" for 2007.

Professor Hall has authored 169 scientific publications to date.
