Diana Mansour, MBBCH, FRCOG, FFSRH, DIPM



Dr Diana Mansour is a Consultant in Community Gynaecology and Reproductive Healthcare and Head of Clinical Service for Sexual Health in Newcastle upon Tyne, UK.

She has been an Associate Clinical Lecturer at Newcastle University since 1997. In addition Dr Mansour is Senior Vice President at the Faculty of Sexual and Reproductive Healthcare, UK. Diana is the Lead Officer for FSRH Clinical Effectiveness Committee, the Clinical Standards Committee, the Clinical Study's Group and FSRH Journal.

Dr Mansour was the first accredited subspecialty trainee in Community Gynaecology and Reproductive Healthcare of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. She is first author to over 80 peer-reviewed publications and has most recently published in Contraception and the BMJ SRH. She co-wrote 'Contraception Made Easy' with Dr Laura Percy for those working in primary care.

Dr Mansour's areas of expertise include acceptability of contraceptive methods, non-contraceptive benefits of contraception, development of long-term methods of contraception, changes in health service provision, medical management of heavy menstrual bleeding, management of the menopause.
