After retiring from his NHS practice, he worked in a private practice in Oxford, as well as doing GP locums for local practices. Last year he helped to set up a Community Dermatology Clinic with the SDS MyHealthCare Federation in South Birmingham and was their Clinical Lead until January this year. He remains a Consultant to this Federation.

He was the RCGP Dermatology Curriculum Guardian from 2010 until 2014, Chair of The Dermatology Council for England from 2014 until July 2018 and a PCDS Committee Member from 2005 until 2018. He remains the Primary Care Advisor to the National Eczema Society.

In his spare time, He enjoys his 7 grandchildren, skiing, walking, playing tennis as well as reading, bridge and chess.
